Hybrid Admission Scheme

Starting from the 2020 intake, the Faculty of Arts will implement a Hybrid Admission Scheme. Applicants may apply for admission to the Bachelor of Arts (Broad-based Admission) or admission to a programme.

Admission scholarships offered to Faculty of Arts students

To award outstanding HKDSE students admitted to the Faculty of Arts students, the Faculty offers a new scholarship starting from the 2020 intake:

Sum of score (4 core + 2 electives)	Amount of scholarship
HKDSE score 30 or above	\$42,100 (one-off, 100% of the first-year tuition)
HKDSE score 29	\$21,050 (one-off, 50% of the first-year tuition)
